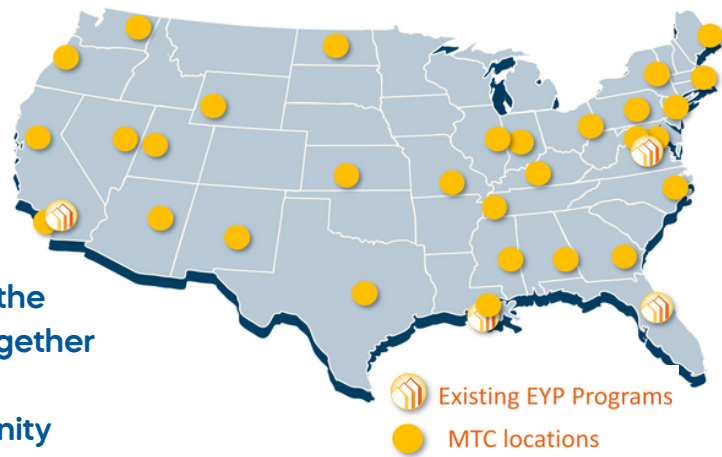


EMPOWERING YOUTH PROGRAM
